



# **RS Data and techniques**

Current and upcoming missions will cover a large range of SAR frequency, X, C, L, S, P band (ALOS-4, NISAR, BIOMASS, Rose-L...)

Sentinel-1 FG/NG - Rose-L SoS (same orbit, same geometry)

operational C and L-band images acquired routinely - wide-swath (hundreds of km) + relatively high-resolution (5m on the ground)



# **Community needs**




- Remote Sensing expertise
